MARYLAND EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT SUBSIDY

The Maryland Office of Statewide Broadband program provides a temporary discount on monthly broadband bills for qualifying households.

This program was developed by the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) and will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households.

The program opened in May and is *temporary* – it will only be available until the funding runs out or until six months after the federal coronavirus “Emergency Period”, as defined by Congress, whichever comes first.

A household is **eligible** if one member of the household meets at least **one** of the criteria below:

- Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, or did so in the 2019-2020 school year
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year
- Experienced a substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020 and the household had a total income in 2020 below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating providers' existing low-income or COVID-19 program
